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INTRODUCTION

ORIGIN OF THE ORGANIZATION: A likeminded group of people registered SAHANUBHUTI, a philanthropic voluntary organization in tribal district of Mayurbahanj ,Odisha in the year 1989.The main motto of the organization then was enhancing socio-economic situation of the rural communities, by implementing activities such as skill development programme for women group and agriculture development programme for farmers . But, it extended its area of operation into Kandhamal, Gajapati and Ganjam district of Odisha to concentrate on health, education, women development and livelihood programme in the year 1999 and has been addressing various issues till date for the sustainable development of its operational area.

After working such a long periods, SAHANUBHUTI has realized that there is a need of empowering the community so that they can resolve their own issues independently with the principles of “help people to help themselves”. This year, due to ongoing CORONA pandemic issue, it had focused on helping its target children by providing education in online class, supporting dry food, hygiene materials, winter gifts, education pack, medicines and health treatment, developing infrastructure and assets. However, the organization took risk in the Pandemic period and throughout year continuously helped the community selflessly and longing to serve the people for their safety and survival of life.

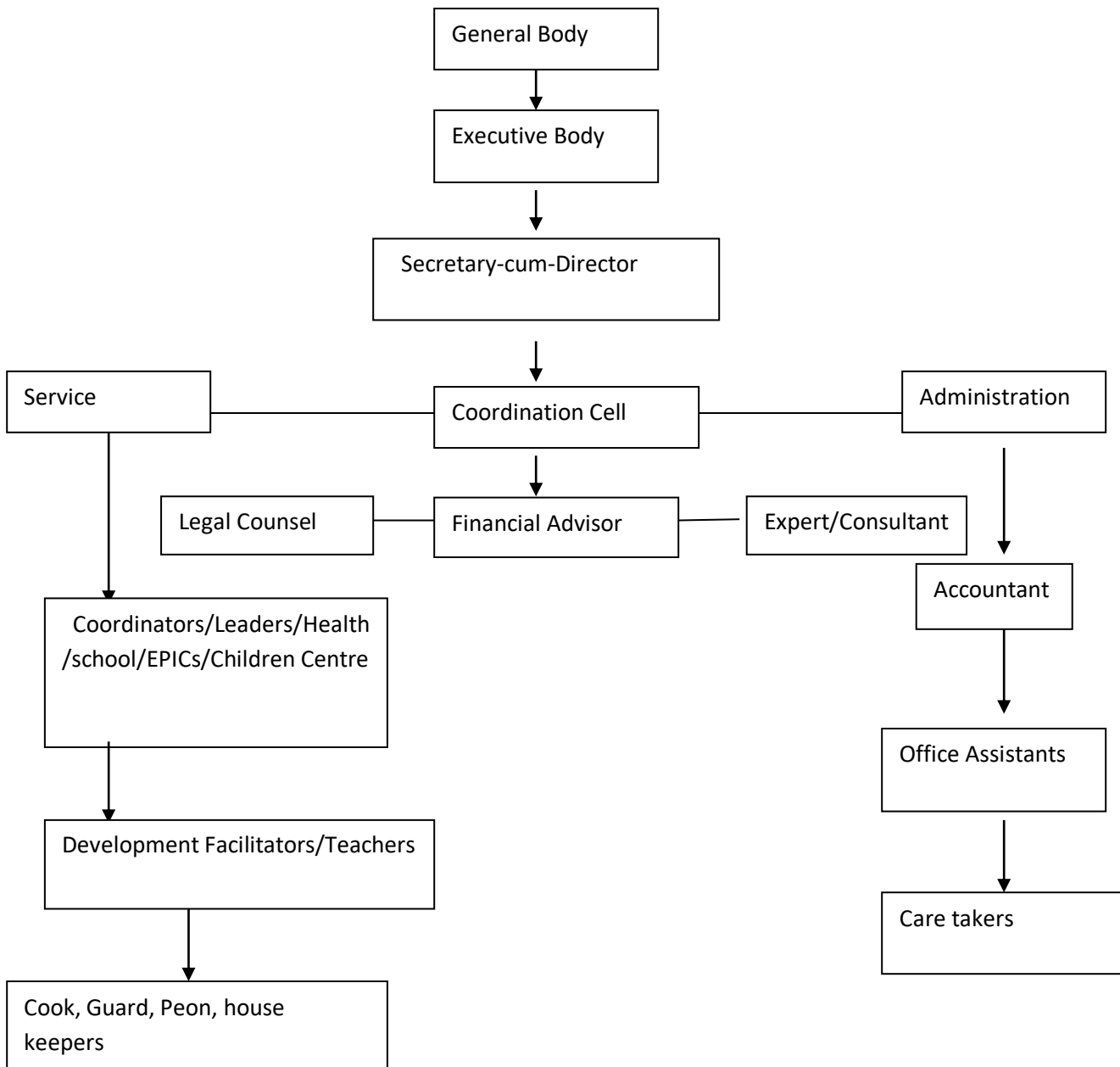

CORE ACTIVITIES OF THE YEAR

LOVE THE ONE PROJECT was the only project implemented by the organization in the year in three districts of Odisha. This project has been implementing its institutional activities since last 2018 which could not be implemented as usual due to ongoing CORONA pandemic, as a result, this year the organization had managed to help its target children by adopting some strategies. Because of the CORONA pandemic, this year, the organization had to close down the hostel programme which was running for last 18 years, also the organization forced to close down the Conflict transformation and peace building programme at community level due to new FC rules of 2020-21.

Love the One project is a holistic child development project focusing basically on education, health care and child care of around 400 marginalized children of Ganjam, Gajapati and Kandhama districts of Odisha. Under this programme, one school, 6 EPICs, one Children Therapy centre for disabled children and one clinic had run, but unfortunately almost whole year due to CORONA restriction, all these centers could not run fully. But the organization managed to help the target children with distribution of dry ration, hygienic kits, study materials, winter gifts, treatment of CORONA infected people by creating isolation centre also helped general health treatment not only to the people of our project area, but also to the people of non project area in all Ganjam, Gajapati and Kandhamal district of Odisha.

HUMAN RESOURCES:

As the organization runs 6 EPICs, one English medium school, one CTC and one clinic, also it has expanded area of operation to Gajapati and Kandhamal district of Odisha, so the strength of the human resource in the project was 154 in last year. There were 50% of professional staffs who were from medical, social work, IT, education and finance sectors. Following are the details of staffs department wise in last year.

Since, the project is basically child centered project and there is a need of woman role in shaping child's future, caring and looking after children properly, therefore the organization had encouraged women group and employed more women candidate in the project as a result, all activities under the project run smoothly and systematically.

The organization conducted following activities in the year, they were:

EDUCATION PROGRAMME:

From the inception, SAHANUBHUTI addresses issue of education in its operational area realizing without education, there is no development. It has implemented various educational activities in past years such as education through hostel, community educational programme, dalit educational programme etc. However, since last three years, under love the project, it run 6 EPICs and one school both in Ganjam and Gajapati districts and all process had completed to start another EPIC in Kandhamal district from next academic year.

Due to prolong presence of CORONA in the year, the school as well as other centers were not opened fully, but conducted various educational activities in different forms among the target children following to the strict guideline of government on CORONA.

EARLY PEDIATRIC INTERVENTIONAL CARE- EPICs:

The project gives more important to run Early Pediatric interventional Care (EPIC), because this is the foundation care centre for the children of the age group below 5 years where kids are fully taken care of their physical, mental and educational development.

This year, there were six EPICs run by the organization out of which one EPIC run in Paralakhemundi of Gajapati district and rest five EPICs run in Ganjam district of Odisha. By the end of last financial year, new EPIC had been planned for implementing in Bamunigoan of Kandhamal district and selection of the target children had been over.

In each EPIC, a team of six to seven staff have got appointed where two teachers, one toddler care taker, one house keeper, one facilitator and health worker were available. Hence around 55 staffs were appointed in last year for all 6 EPICs to take care of kids in the field of health, education and child care.

During lock down period due to CORONA, teachers were attended centers regularly and conducted online classes for the children .However, online classes were not much effective as many children were not accessing mobiles also getting concentration of kids was very hard in online classes. It was because of all children were below 5 years old. Still 30 percent children were covered in online classes regularly also almost 20% courses of EPICs were covered during the lockdown period.



Time to time community visit programme was made by concern centre staffs to discuss with parents about the situation of the kids and their health and to aware health and educational status .Also to make aware about CORONA, especially about how to keep safe the children during CORONA period. The community visit was very much helpful



for the kids as there were frequently kept touch with their teachers and got lots of guidance to develop them by engage themselves in different activities in their houses. However, in the case of EPIC of Paralakhemundi , physical classes were conducted with the support of community people where all EPIC enrolled children attended throughout the year. There was a cooperation and involvement in running this centre. The community basically supported community hall to run the centre, provided utensils to prepare food for the children as a result, standard of the children had improved a lot and kids had taken care well in education, health and child care aspects.

However from January 2022, after declaration by government about opening schools, all 6 EPICs also opened and physical classes and other activities conducted as usual. Children's day gifts were distributed to all children in the month of November, Since there was no centers opened due to CORONA, so there was no celebration neither birth day nor children's day took place for kids. Therefore, the organization purchased different gifts for all children and distributed in their respective centres. And the children enjoyed a lot.

LOVE THE ONE SCHOOL:

Since last three year, SAHANUBHBUTI runs Love the One school .Last year, the school upgraded to 8th standard where almost 281 students got admitted. All students were from our target communities who promoted from our 5 EPICs run in different communities. The detail of the students of the school were as follows:

The school run in four rented buildings where classes had distributed based on availability of rooms. All buildings were in closer to each other which helped teachers to attended classes after opening schools. However, primary level students who were in certain building had separate kitchen in order to feed timely and properly.



This year also the organization had struggled to run the school .However, following to the COVID restriction of Government norms, teachers of the schools conducted online classes for higher class students till lifting up the COVID restriction. Hence, the organization supported 10 mobiles to 10 poor higher class students



to access online class



and supported net charge for all teachers to conduct classes. Though it was not much effective but it helped students to engage in study assigning home works regularly.

Books and other study materials as well as two pairs of school uniforms have distributed to all students even during the lock down period so that students can continue their study at home. Three unit tests conducted during lock down period in online basis and last unit test as well as annual exams were conducted after opening the centre .In order to fill the gap of some teachers who left the schools for different reasons, new teachers got appointment.



Times to time teachers were provided training by principal as well as senior teachers about teaching methods, running classes, and development of the students in education as well as about improvement of students' character. There was a science exhibition conducted in the schools where students had exhibited various science related activities to the parents and other visitors. It was a great time for the students to expose their inner talents. Some selected students were also participated in district level sports competition and few of them were selected for next level competition which was a matter of pride for the school.



In order to have well set up classes and office rooms, the organizations developed with new furniture like chairs and tables for students, chairs for teachers and guests, long benches for higher class students also developed computer labs for students where 10 laptops purchased. Apart from this, there was repairing work of new building which was rented this year for lower class students.



The school also celebrated students and staff's birth day .Due to COVID, it was hard to celebrate individuals' birthday, so after normal period, group birth day was celebrated and gifts were distributed to all students.

CLINIC:

Clinic had played important roles not only during CORONA period but also other normal days . Basically it had a medical support for all children who were covered in the project as well as the family members and other people of the project villages.



There were 16 staffs engaged in the centre. Out of 16, 8 were nurses, one health mobilizer, one accountant , one admin staff , one driver , one maintenance staff and 3 numbers of housekeeping staffs.

The major activity conducted in the clinic were conducting health checks and provide medicines, helping children in surgery for different dieses also referring children into different local hospitals as well as hospitals of other states like Hyderabad, Visakhapatnam, Delhi etc for surgery and other better treatment.



As much as 921 kids went for health check up to clinic of the project and took medicines for different dieses, around 195 children who got admit in CHB for different health issue and got support from the organization, around 111 children got support for conducting test in NIDAN, local Diagnosis centre, 12 children went through eye check up and treatment , 27 children got orthopedric check up and treatment in private hospital named Patro hospital , 19 children got dental treatment and 15 children got surgery for different diseases in



STAR HOSPITAL HYDERABAD, NEW DELHI, VISHAKPATNAM also in SUM HOSPITAL & KIMS HOSPITAL of Bhubaneswar, Odisha.



Apart from this, with the initiative of clinic team around 50 staff had facilitated to take COVID vaccine timely. Apart from this, a temporary isolation centre was opened in one of the school building of the project where two COVID affected families were took shelter and got treatment from the project freely till they got negative test result.

The clinic team had also celebrated NURSE Day on 8th September 2021. It was the time to remember the contribution and hard work of the NURSES of the project. The directors, senior level staffs and all clinic staffs were present in the celebration where various cultural activities conducted by the team in a simple way.



During the year, the organization also developed with some medical equipment, IT materials and some furniture and assets like Ambulance and Jeep for providing better health service to the children as well as to the communities. Due to all dedicated staffs of the clinic, health service during year was very much successful and beneficial to our entire target children including community people during this CORONA PANDEMIC period.



CHILDREN THERAPY CENTRE (CTC):

Children Therapy Centre is completely the centre runs for special children who are physically and mentally disorder. There were 15 such children admitted in the centre during the year and they had been taken care on various physical therapy, proper



clothing, food, medicines, education and other cares..In order to provide quality and best service, the organization had appointed 15 staffs to take care of the children including centre in charge and Physic Therapists.

During the year, especially COVID period, both online and physical therapy classes were conducted by the trained staffs. Various therapy activities were conducted for each child based on their physical needs. Seven children who were physically disorder provided with Physical therapy, five children who were little normal provided with proper education, Two children who had problem with hearing and speaking, helped them attending special class for their growth of speech and hearing and one child who was blind, supported him sending blind school for his education. And it was found that due to constant therapy and support, around 70% of the children had improved a lot from their deficiency.



The centre had provided birth day gifts, winter special programme gifts, and observed children's day, teachers' day, disable day where various cultural activities were conducted in each celebration and helped children to expose their different talents and capacities. The team of the centre had taken hardship to provide full care of the special children throughout the year to bring them into main stream and they were partially succeeded.



WINTER PROGRAMME:

Though the organization could not conducted winter programme this year for the kids, due to COVID, however, various valuable items such as sleeping bags, mosquito nets, bathing soap, hand gel, mask, different toys, musical key boards, different notes, color pencils, metal plate, and steel glass were distributed to all 417



children who were enrolled in different centers and schools of both Ganjam, Gajapati district and Kandhamal district. Mostly the programme conducted by visiting streets and home to the children and distributed with songs and dance to make kids happy and cheerful.

OBSERVATION OF SPECIAL DAYS:

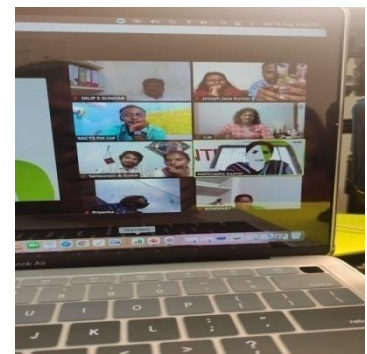
The organization observed various important days such as Independent day, Republic day, teacher's day, children's day and nurse day during the reporting period .It also celebrated birthday of all children on their birth date. In each observation, events were organized following to the COVID



guidelines and norms that were prescribed by Government. In every event, various cultural activities were conducted. Especially in Teacher's day, children had performed various cultural activities, where as in children's day, teachers were conducted different activities. However, in Republic and Independence day, only staffs celebrated the day in a simple way manner.

CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME

The organization had organized various staff capacity building training programme for the staffs during the year such as Vision of the project, leadership and management, core values of the programme, teacher's training, child protection policies etc. Apart from this , the organization took part some trainings & workshops organized by some other NGOs/ institutions in physical as well as virtual where some of core staffs took part in those training which was very much helpful for the NGO.



CORONA RESPONSE PROGRAMME:

The organization had engaged fully in CORONA response activities like previous year by supporting dry rations, medical support to the COVID patients and making isolation centre for COVID patients and their primary treatment.

During first quarter of the year in COVID grave period, 3 patients who were severely infected by COVID were sifted to Bhubaneswar with the support of Ambulance of our organization and two of them were got well where as one patient was expired after one week long treatment. The patient was the father of a child who was enrolled in our project school.



Four COVID infected persons from locality were severely infected in COVID and they were admitted in Christian hospital with our support. All were got long treatment from seven to 15 days. And after long treatment all four were fully cured.

Apart from this, the organization supported many patients who died due to COVID and in different dieses during the COVID time were provided transport facility to take their village in free of cost. Also the organization prepared isolation centre for primary treatment of the COVID patients and there were around three families who were took shelter in the centre and got treatment.



The organization also distributed dry rations, hygiene packs to the families of the children who were enrolled in our project. During the year three times dry rations, twice hygienic pack was supported to the children in order to have sufficient food, good hygiene and proper education. Education packs items were distributed among all EPICS as well as school children. Because of timely supported all these items, children had

enough rations, good hygiene and proper education throughout year even in the CORONA pandemic period. The details of the items distributed were as follows:

CONCLUSION:

SAHANUBHUTI had again taken constant effort to support in different ways to the community during the grave period of CORONA. This year, mostly support was limited to the children and their families of the project area as a result there was a good impact of the programme. The organization was quite satisfied in its work done during this year. It has also planned for more programme to be implemented in coming year to bring more changes in the lives of the community.

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
