

# **CORE ACTIVITIES OF THE YEAR :**

# **PEOPLES ORGANIZATION :**

SAHANUBHUTI is totally committed to the cause of people. All its programmes are people orientated. But people in the target area who live in utter poverty with high illiteracy rate lacked organization to



raise their voice. But with the intervention of SAHANUBHUTI people in the target area developed the concept of organization. After frequent meeting with different leaders of the society, a village Development Committee has been formed in every village of the target area. SAHANUBHUTI provides them timely guidance to voice their rights in an organized manner. SAHANUBHUTI conducted capacity building programme for the VDC members to strengthen the VDC. It gave them awareness to first for basic human rights. A lot of social and economic changes have taken place with the joint effort of SAHANUBHUTI and people's organization in the target area. All the developmental activities initiated by SAHANUBHUTI are well co-operated by people through organization. SAHANUBHUTI also takes care that these activities take the concept of sustainable development for the well being of the people in the target area.

# WOMEN DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

# **Strengthening SHG**

SAHANUBHUTI is making constant effort so bring about changes in the society through women group. It is focusing a special attention on the up gradation of women in the society. In order to build the capacity of the women



and involve them in all social activities SAHANUBHUTI has promoted 120 SHGs in the target area. The SHG members are given different trainings to capacitate them. It organized SHG management training and 240 representatives of different SHG participated in the training. During the training the participants were imparted though information on the meaning and scope of SHG its organizational management, financial management, accountability and responsibility & linkages with different agencies to tap resources. Now the 80% SHGs are able to save their monthly income with inter-leaning system. 60% of the SHGs have made linkages with their respective blocks and 40% of them have received loans for various IGP Programme. 10% of the SHGs are involved in cultivating ginger & turmeric and 20% SHGs are engaged with pig rearing & goat rearing. Now with their income and activities the SHG have earned dignity and respect in the society.

#### Training programme to women for economic development :

In order to empower women and make their group a platform for all social changes and development, SAHANUBHUTI has stood by the SHGs in their fight and social justice and equal rights. In this regard SAHANUBHUTI conducted 3 nos. training for the SHGs. As many as 130 selected members from 7 SHGs participated in 3 Income Generation Activities training namely Tailoring, Food Processing and Pig rearing. A brief note of each training as follows:

## (a) Tailoring Training :

Tailoring training was participated by 20 members from different SHGs. The training lasted for 3 months with an exposure trip to Berhampur. The participants were trained



on skill of cutting and stitching of short pant, shirt, trousers, blouse and other

designs. After the training each participant was provided with a machine and raw materials. The impact of the training was far-reaching as the trainees have started generating income. They are also training other members of their group.

# (b) Food Processing:

SAHANUBHUTI organized Food Processing training for 80 participants from different SHGs. The skill or Papad making was given to 20participants. The art

of pickles making was received by 20 participants, 20 participants learnt the method of Mudi making and the rest 20 were trained on the process of Bodi making.



The training lasted for 21 days and after the training the participants were provided with raw material for food processing. The training was really fruit bearing as the trainees are making a good living out the Food Processing. Requests are being made from other SHG members of the society to arrange a training for them as well.

#### (c) Pig rearing

A week long pig rearing training was imparted 20 members from different SHGs. During the training, the participants learnt how to rear pig and make good income for pig rearing. A through knowledge on pig rearing i.e. the process of accommodation, Food supply and medicine etc was explained to the participants. The concept of marketing of pig was also explained in detail. It is hoped that the participants will soon start pig rearing for generating income.

#### Awareness Programme for destitute women:

SAHANUBHUTI has identified as many as 18 destitute women who are indulged with sex practice. Effort has been made to teach women an safe sex and consequences of sex practices such as HIV/AIDS and other diseases. SAHANUBHUTI is making untiring effort to rehabilitate these destitute and bring them to the mainstream of the society.

# **EMPOWERMENT OF YOUTH :**

Youth are the most active and effective agent for social change. They need guidance and support in their endeavor to bring about changes in society. In this regard 'SAHANUBHUTI' worked hard and setup Youth club in every village of the target area. The youth clubs are registered and hold monthly meetings. SAHANUBHUTI organized a programme for the capacity building of the youth. During the programme the youth were sanitized an all issues of the society and their duty and responsibility on bringing about changes in society. The capacity building programme also featured the participations of youth in all programme of the community. A special light was thrown on Selfreliance by adopting different Income Generation Activities.

#### Sport Competition among youth:

In order to develop better interaction among the youth of the target area, SAHANUBHUTI successfully conducted a sports competition for the youth. At least 400 youth of the target area and participated in the event. The participants were divided into 4 groups. They chose their respective capatians. At the end of the competition the Sarapanch of Bamunigam distributed prizes to winners. The competition helped the participants to know each other. Moreover, the hidden talents of the participants came into light. These discovered new talents could be utilized for the betterment of the society.

#### Health Programme

#### **Dispensary Service:**

The people in the target area really need proper health care, as they don't have access to any public treatment facilities. In order to provide healthcare and transmit the knowledge of proper hygiene



SAHANUBHUTI run a dispensary in the target area. The dispensary is rendering a great health service to the people of the target area. People from 100 villages of 3 districts flock to avail treatment facilities. The health professionals of the dispensary are rendering all kinds of services around O'clock. The dispensary has a safe place for child-delivery. It is heartening to note that the dispensary registers 10 to 12 cases of child delivery in a month. Besides child-delivery, treatment is also provided for other health hazards such as malaria, T.B. jaundice and diarrhea. Thanks to its treatment and service, the dispensary has made a big headway in 3 districts. A big hospital with every facility by SAHANUBHUTI in this area would service the purpose better.

# Health camp :

Realizing the need of health in its target area, SAHANUBHUTI had organsied health camp thrice in three different places in the year. Around 750 people form three place took these



advantages. Mr. J. Senapati, the surgeon of city Hospital Berhampur was invited and the staff from Sahanubhuti assisted him. Freely people were got health check up and received medicine. Disease like cough, malaria, T.B. diarrhea, back pain, eye problem, pneumonia etc were diagnosed and treated. It was a great benefit for the people of the area, as getting this type of treatment is very rare in the area and also access to health service by the Govt. hospital is lacking.

Earlier the staff from SAHANUBHUTI made aware about the community health and sanitation, also the doctor gave various tips in the camp about preventive and curative measures of health.

## Dental camp.

The people of 3 districts suffer a lot of dental problems due to the lack of dental clinic in the target area. In order to provide free dental treatment and sensitize people on dental care, SAHANUBHUTI organized a dental camp. Dr. Biswanath Panigrahi along with his team from MKCG Medical hospital Berhampur conducted the camp. As many as 520 people participated in the camp and received free treatment. They had their teeth check up and freely received the dental service of teeth cleaning, root canal therapy, orthodontist veneer, Crownt Bridge, fixed and remove prosthesis and other advance methods of fillings. People of all sections in the target area appreciated the initiation for the organization of such 'dental camp'. Requests are made to SAHANUBHUTI to conduct such camp in their Panchayat headquarters or villages.

#### Sensitization to Youth on HIV/AIDS:

As HIV/AIDS is emerging as the biggest threat and spreading its tentacles like wildfire the youth need to be sensitized on it. Due to the lack of employment facilities, many youth of the target area have migrate to neighboring cities to seek fortunes. They come across female sex workers and develop the possibilities of HIV/AIDS. So, SAHANUBHUTI organized a sensitization camp on HIV/AIDS for the youth of the target area. As many as 300 youth participated in the camp. Mr. Manoj Sahu & Ms. Sucheta Das counselors, VCCTC BAM conducted the camp as resource personnel. They explained about HIV/AIDS, it modes of infection, prevention aspects, counseling and special care & support to People living with HIV/AIDS. They also throw special light on safe migration and safe sex. The impact of the programme was very fruitful, as the participants have stated disseminating the information to their peer group members.

# **EDUCATION**

#### **Orphanage :**

SAHANUBHUTI aims at bringing about changes in the society through

education. Therefore it has been running an orphanages for the last3 years, where children are freely accommodated and their educational progress is greatly taken care of .Now there are 100 inmates in the orphanage



and half of them are girls. The orphanage takes all care of these inmates. Besides school teachings they have been provided with special classes by experts to enhance their standard. They are also given special classes on morality, spirituality and etiquette. To equip them for future they are imparted training on tailoring, gardening and agricultural activities. Thanks to the ceaseless effort of the staff, the orphanage has become 'Alma matter' for the inmates.

Apart from this SAHANUBHUTI has strengthened and empower to Village Education Committee in every villages, as a result the school in every village functions well and it has been controlled the drop out rates, also the teachers and children are becoming regular in the schools.

## Agricultural development:

Most of the people of the target area are agriculturist. But the traditional method of tilling and irregular monsoon doesn't yield expected crops in the target area. So, with a view of bringing a drastic change in the field of at agriculture,

SAHANUBHUTI organized a farmer mobilization camp twice in the year. During the camp the farmers were taught the use of modern technique in agricultural sector for better yielding. The provision of Govt. and way means to tap these resources were made aware to the participants. Detailed information a Panipanchayat was also given to the participants. Besides land cultivation the participants were also sanitized an other agro-based activities like Kitchen garden a special discussion was held raising Grain Bank & Seed Bank to help the farmers. In this regard SAHANUBHUTI has surveyed an area of 99 hectres for watershed programme. It is going to start the watershed programme in the proposed site in near future.

#### **ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION:**

The target area was full of trees and forest. Forest was the second source of income for the people. They collected five wood, fruits, honey and other precious materials, which gave them good income. But



with the advent of woodcutters and other business groups the dense forest of the area started degrading. The mass cutting of forest resulted in gambling rainfall and affected agriculture adversely. SAHANUBHUTI realizing the situations initiated different programmes for Forest conservation. It conducted forest management twice in a year. The advantages of forest and the adverse effects of forest destruction and the role of the participants etc are explained in detail during the camps. Thanks to the effort of SAHANUBHUTI each village has set up a Forest conservation committee. The committee is taking utmost care to conserve forest and protect it from the destruction of the outsiders. The committee is empowered to impose five or punishment for woodcutters.

#### **Observation of importance days:**

#### (i) International women day

SAHANUBHUTI have celebrated the day to boost the moral of the women to live with dignity and respectfully. Near about 300 women representatives were took part in this day. Guests from different field like education, legal, political and all other



joined in the day and encouraged the women on their situation, position and explained them how to fight for their rights. Most of the guests were asked them to be united or to form women association in G.P. or Block level in order to stand against various atrocities of women. They also discussed about the importance of SHG and its scope. Many guests expressed their opinion that economic development of women will bring in to the social respect and dignity within family and in the society. This celebration has motivated many women association to stand strongly against women atrocities and to fight for their rights in later stage.

#### **Independence and Republic day :**

The organization has observed independence and republic day on 15<sup>th</sup> August and 26<sup>th</sup> Jan respectively to mark its importance and to remember the people who became example to be followed and to maintain the harmony, peace and join hands for the development of the nation. The concern Zilla Parishad and the chairman were the Chief guests for both the function who in their speech explained the importance of the days and the lesson that we should carry in our life. The children of the orphanage had presented various dance and songs to make the day grand and enjoyable. Various competitions were organized earlier and prizes were distributed to the winner children.

# International labour day:

The people in the target area of SAHANUBHUTI constitutes 60% labourer. However they do not ware their rights. And they get exploits in their wages from contractor. Zamindar, Sahukar also from government sectors. In order to aware this section of people, sahanubhuti had organsied labour day. Where 300 representatives from the area were took part. Local guest like GPO, Zillaparishad, Chairman, Sarapanchs, Teachers, Advocate were invited as the guest of the day who vividly exampled in their speech about the situation of the labour and form exploitation. It was encouraged people to be wrote in village, Panchayat and block level, so that they could fight against every sectors where they get exploits. In later stage, people in village level in the area have strengthened their village committee which as the nodal agency in the village to look after all developmental issues of the villages.
