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INTRODUCTION

ORIGIN OF THE ORGANIZATION: SAHANUBHUTI, a philanthropic voluntary organization initiated its activities in the tribal district of Mayurbahanj ,Odisha in its early 1989 with some likeminded group of people. To improve the socio-economic situation of the rural communities, the organization implemented activities such as skill development programme for women group and agriculture development programme for farmers. But after registration of the organization in the year 1989, it expanded its area of operation to Kandhamal, Gajapati and Ganjam district of Odisha and till date it addresses issues such as health, education, livelihood, women and peace building.

SAHANUBHUTI has a vast experiences working with the community and has realized very much about the real situations and needs of the people and accordingly takes effort to help people to help themselves. This year, it has implemented very few activities focusing on children development and peaceful coexistence of the communities in its operational area. However, the organization is in its continuous whole hearted effort, commitment and zealous dedication in the service of people which has led to establish its own identity and recognition in its target area and longing to serve the people till to achieve a transformational change in marginalized community.



CORE ACTIVITIES OF THE YEAR

PEACE BUILDING AND CONFLICT TRANFROMATION PROGRAMME:

Peace Building and Conflict Transformation programme has completed its 2nd phase in the

month of January 2019. The 3rd phase programme has started from February 2019 in same 9 villages of Adava under Mohona block of Gajapati district. It implements along with other 10 civil society organizations under the lead NGO named SWAD which is based at Berhampur of Ganjam district. Soon after the riots of 2007-08, the state of Odisha especially Kandhamal district and its

adjacent district became sensitive area. The people of these areas had lost their trust and faith upon the co-communities who were living with them since generation. Day by day



different conflict has been arisen among them. Looking to build the peace and transform the conflict, the organization has been implementing the programme from 2012.

This year with the support of KZE/Misereor and Mensen Mest Een Missie, Netherland, the programme

implemented based on three objectives, they are 1. Identify major conflicts, 2. Create peaceful environment and 3. Promote peace network in the state. With the collaboration of partners and stake holders, the organization identified various conflicts such as identity based, natural based and gender based conflicts and 50% of them have been resolved by village level and GP level empowered peace development committee. It has also created peaceful environment almost all targeted villages by implementing various common livelihood programmes. The common livelihood programmes such are IGP activities by SHGs, making participation by the communities in their cultural events etc. It has also promoted peace network in the state level by inviting likeminded NGOs, individuals, social activists, journalists, lawyers and others govt departments. This programme has really put a great impact in the area as people are now understanding about peace and how to bring conflict transformation. Still it has been very challenging but it implements carefully with the cooperation of both communities in each village.

LOVE THE ONE PROGRAMME:

This year SAHANUBHUTI has implemented **Community Paediatric and Educational Outreach Project**, **'Love the One'** which is basically child focused programme for the children from very poor back ground and also for special need children(handicapped/disables children) implementing in urban area of Gnajam district and rural area of Gajapati districts of Odisha. The programme was supported by Love the One UK. The main aim of the programme is to protect and promote basic child rights by providing health, education and child care activities.

Under health programme it implements clinic and children centre activities which are based at Berhampur and the activities are as follows:

Clinic



Clinic plays a pivotal role in rendering primary health service to the children of the Love the one school, all EPICs, children centre and also children of different communities. The onsite clinic continued to give health care provision for the children already attending the other programs and for children who needed more extended reviews due to a more complex medical condition that

had already been seen in the mobile clinics.

During this time period, health camp was conducted twice in a needy and poor area of Nilakanthanagar village of Kashinagar block of Gajapati district near to Paralakhemundi city. Around 300 children from the village as well as from nearby villages were got health checks and received free medicines. Voluntary doctors, nurses and a laboratory technician were engaged in the camp also the voluntary directors who are the pediatric doctors involved fully in the clinical and health camp programme.



Children's Centre:

The 'Children's Centre' is one of the hope and life saving centre for the children with mental and physical disability. During this period it has been running in a very organized way. The children had been provided not only food and special care but also various therapy and teachings were conducted through different medium such as audio visual,

games, toys, and other sports items. There were 12 such children given service in the reporting period. The centre had also organized week long therapy treatment service for such special children where around 30 children from local to Berhampur as well as from remote areas of neighboring district took part and availed the service from the centre.

A number of volunteer doctors, nurses, occupational and physio therapists and medical students extended their services during this time which was very encouraging for the team of our centre. This Therapy week programme was not only helped to the children but also to the team of our centre who equipped with lots of insights and knowledge of treatment of such children.



Early Pediatric Interventional Care Centre (EPIC Centre)



There are 6 such types of centres run in the communities covering 180 children at the age group of 1 to below 5 years and each centre provides 30 children with full healthcare, education, by learning through play and high quality childcare for children in needy communities such as Khodasing, Geta slum, Khaja street, Dharampur and Nauli.

The centres run by local mothers and continue to provide excellent play based care for all the children. The children had taken care with supply of nutritious intake, child friendly education comprising games, storytelling, drawing etc. The team members have received training time to time throughout the year by the priciniplal of the EPICs as well by the experts from volunteers.



Love the One School



Love the one school is also another activity of love the one programme where poor and street children of the Berhampur city and its neighboring village get education .It was opened formally in April 2016 with 'Bridge' program course. There are 5 classes in the school starts from LKG - Standard 5. Many of the children in the previous Bridge program for school dropouts are now in the Love the One school. The school follows the CBSE English Medium



curriculum. Many thanks go to the dedicated teachers who believe in a vision where no child is beaten and every child has the opportunity to learn in a safe environment. Many extracurricular activities also regularly took place at the school including music and sports activities. The school observed its annual day as well as many importance day such as Annual day, science day, Independent, Republic, teachers' and children's day in a

grand way. Teachers were equipped with lots of trainings time to time throughout the year by the experts of volunteers on innovative, child friendly and various methods of teachings. Apart

from, as a member of school association in the district, the teachers attended various education related meetings and workshops conducted by the education department, govt of Odisha and had lots of knowledge and experiences. The school also conducted quarterly once parents teacher's meeting that really helped parents as well as teachers to aware fully about the educational status of the children..



Observation of Important Days

The organization had observed many importance days both in the school as well as in all the

Children's exposure trips and Making Memories



The children had a number of excursions outside including a trip to hot spring spot (Taptapani) the mountains and a number of trips to the beach. The EPIC children got to visit the fire station and learn all about the emergency services. All the children very much enjoyed their trips out of the school and it helped them to understand more about their

state and the different places that can be visited.

Winter Holiday Children's Programs

As a child centered organization, it likes to create fun and enjoyment among the children every time wherever it gets opportunity. The organization organized Winter Holiday Children programme among the children of Gajapati and Ganjam where Love the One works. The programme was organized at Paralakhemunid of Gajapati districts in the month of Novemebr 2018, where around 250 children took part and enjoyed the party. In the same way, the winter party had organized at Berhampur in the month of December 2018 and around 400 children from all centres of love the programme as well as children from the communities where love the one works took part. The activities such as group games, group dance, skits and other fun activities conducted among the children in both parties. It was really amazing and children enjoyed a lot .All children were distributed with lots of gift and prizes based on their talents and all were very happy.

Staff Capacity Building

The organization had organized several capacities building training prorgammes for both senior level staff as well as for all the staff of the programme. Three days training programme was organized for senior leaders on team building .Mr Will muttan and Tom from England were vividly enlighten to the senior staffs consisting 10 members in the month of November 2018. Apart from this, quarterly once, planning meeting had conducted for senior leaders. Monthly staff gathering and orientation meeting had been conducted every month for all staff. The voluntary directors provided inputs to all staff about the ethos and aims of the charity and to ensure that they understand how to work in the spirit of the six core values of the organization. Emphasis was also given on training and equipping the staff to know

exactly how to look after the children in a loving way through play and comprehension rather than by rote and to know how to discipline children in a positive way. It was really helpful for the staffs to gain various knowledge and skills to run the activities smoothly and effectively.
